After deliberations and detailed discussions on the medical, laboratory and treatment records of these cases the State Dengue Death Review Committee was of the opinion that out of the 20 death cases reviewed from various districts, one case (Vishal Anand from SAS Nagar at S.NO. 12) was found to have died due to Dengue. 4 cases were kept in suspected deaths due to dengue due to non availability of the medical and laboratory records. One patient Mr Tiryogi Narain from SAS Nagar has been kept pending.
