**Subject:** Recording of medical records of dengue patients reg-

Reference subject mentioned above, this is to inform you that the following issues has to be addressed whenever a probable/confirmed case of dengue is admitted in a hospital in your district and case of suspected/confirmed death due to dengue is reviewed at your level.

1. As per notification issued by Govt. of Punjab vide No. 16/46/86-3BIV/605910/1 dated 08.10.2015, use of RDKs for confirmation of dengue is not recommended. A patient found positive with RDK will be a probable case of dengue. The patient should be confirmed as a case of dengue as per ELISA test (NS1 Antigen or IgM Mac ELISA). The instructions should be issued to all the Govt and Private Hospitals in your district as Dengue is a notified disease and it is mandatory for all hospitals to inform Civil Surgeon of the respective district to do so.

2. The medical record of every probable/confirmed case of dengue should have clear recommendations of fluid by the treating physician and input/output record should be maintained for every case.

3. Tourniquet test should be done and findings be recorded in each case of probable/confirmed case of dengue.

4. The National guidelines for management of dengue should be adhered to while managing a case of dengue. The guidelines can be downloaded from the webportal of Govt. of Punjab at [www.punjabnvbdcp.in](http://www.punjabnvbdcp.in)

5. The treating physician and incharge of hospital (Govt/Private) shall be responsible for implementation of the above instructions.
